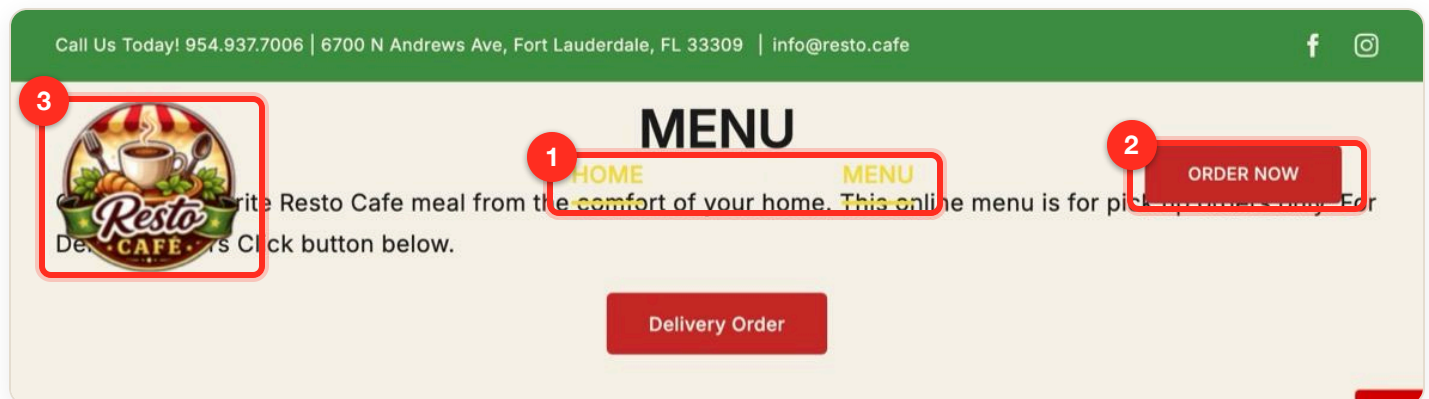

Hey, thanks for getting back to me. Like I mentioned, I took a little time on your site and jotted down a few things I noticed. Nothing is broken, and none of it is a big deal to fix. I just marked each one on a screenshot so it's easy to see what I mean, and added simple steps for fixing it. Hope it's helpful either way.

THE MAIN ONE

1. The top of the page falls apart at half-screen

On a full phone your site actually holds together fine. But when someone shrinks their browser to about half the screen, which a lot of people do on a laptop, the whole top collapses on itself.

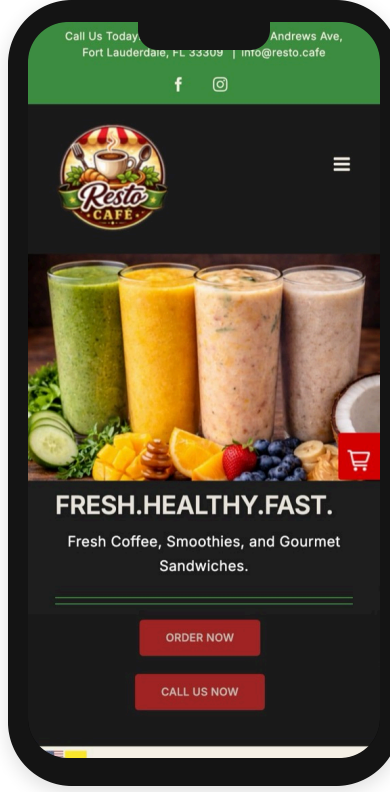


What's happening in that screenshot:

- 1 The HOME / MENU links float loose, right on top of the paragraph text.
- 2 The red ORDER NOW button lands on top of the words on the other side.
- 3 The logo slides over and covers the big "MENU" heading.

The fix: a header with proper breakpoints so it keeps its shape at every width. This one is a theme fix, more on that at the end.

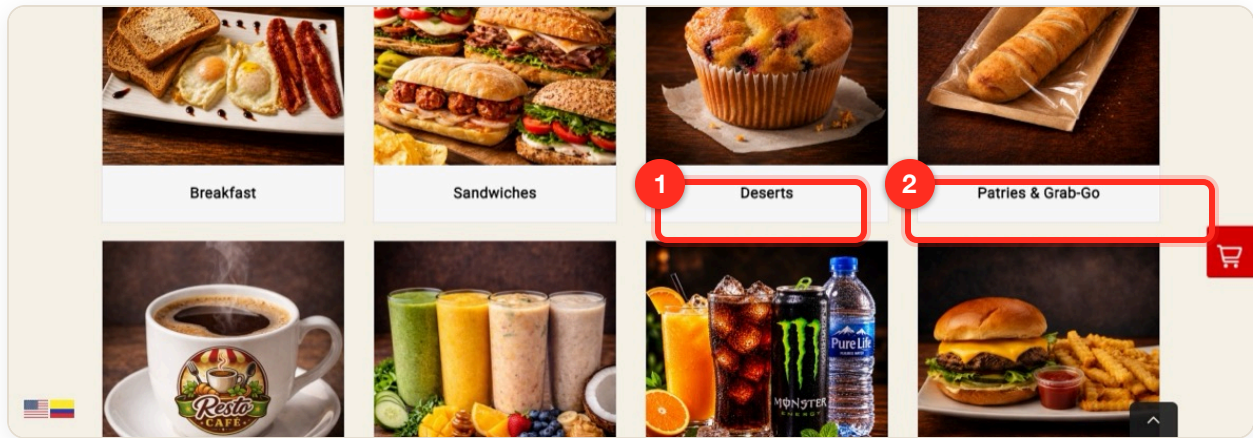
The good news: on an actual phone, it holds together just fine.

WORTH A QUICK FIX

2. A couple of typos in the menu

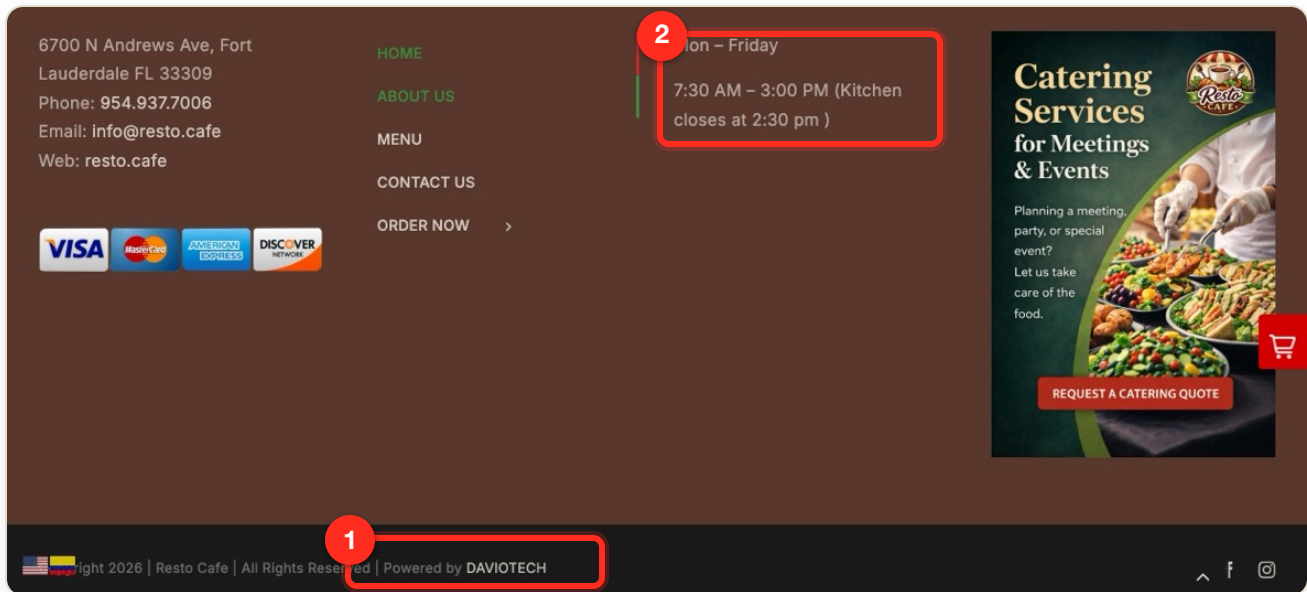


- 1 “Deserts” should be “Desserts.” (A desert is sand.)
- 2 “Patries” should be “Pastries.” There’s also a “gourment” (gourmet) in your About text.

The fix: a two-minute proofread. Little errors on a food site can make people quietly wonder about the food too.

SMALL THING

3. A couple of things in the footer



- 1 Down in the corner it says “Powered by DAVIOTECH,” the company that built the site left its own name on your footer.
- 2 Your hours only list Monday to Friday. If you're open (or closed) on weekends, it's worth saying so, otherwise people just guess.

The fix: remove the builder's name and spell out your full hours, including the weekend even if it's just “Closed.”

A couple of behind-the-scenes notes, in case they're useful: the page has no main heading for Google to read, more than half your images (12 of 18) are missing their alt text (the short description Google and screen readers use), and the oversized images make it a little slow to load on a phone.

How to fix it yourself

Most of this you (or whoever helps with the site) can do today in WordPress. The half-screen header is the one exception, that's a theme fix. Here's the honest split.

Quick wins you can do today (log in at resto.cafe/wp-admin):

- 1 **Fix the typos.** In the page editor (or Appearance > Menus), retype “Desserts” and “Pastries” in the menu, and fix “gourmet” in the About text.
- 2 **Add your weekend hours.** Edit the footer (Appearance > Widgets, or the footer template) and add Saturday and Sunday, even if it's “Closed.”
- 3 **Add the missing photo descriptions.** Go to Media > Library, click each photo, and fill the “Alt text” box.
- 4 **Hide the stray cart icon on the hero.** In Slider Revolution, open your slider, click the Phone icon above the canvas, select that little cart layer, and switch it off for phone.

The header, which needs your builder or a developer:

The half-screen header overlap lives in the theme's code, so it isn't a simple setting. The cleanest path is to ask **DavioTech** (the builder in your footer) to “fix the tablet/half-width header that overlaps the page text,” or have any WordPress developer take a look.

And if you'd ever like a hand with any of it, I'm glad to help, no pressure at all.
